Resource links: Research the event - Day of the Dead on the internet.	Task(s): Design a poster to advertise the Mexican holiday – Day of the Dead. Include lettering, drawings, images, dates and information about this event.

Resource links: Look at images of the game – Insanely Twisted Shadow Planet on the internet.	Task(s): Design a vehicle for the computer game character that you are designing in lessons. Remember it needs to fit with the game – Insanely Twisted Shadow Planet.
YEAR 9	
Resource links: Look at images of famous cityscapes/skylines like New York, London, Tokyo etc... on the internet to help you with your ideas.	Task(s): Create your own drawn cityscape/skyline. You can include architecture from anywhere in the world. Add tone with pencils and annotate with your thoughts about the different styles of architecture that you have included in your drawing.

Resource links: Select one painting by Salvador Dali to look at on the internet.	Task(s): Critical Analysis Research the Artist Salvador Dali. Select one of his paintings to look at. Describe what you can see. Does the work have a name? When was it created? What has inspired it? What is it about? What materials have been used to create it and how? What is the composition like? Describe the colour, texture, tone, line? What do you like about it? Why have you chosen it? How does it make you feel? What ideas could you take from it?
