Year 11 Prom 2025

We are pleased to inform you of the date for the Year 11 Prom. It will take place at the Bristol Marriott Royal Hotel, College Green, Bristol, on **Thursday, 26th June, 2025**, from 6.45 pm until 10.15 pm. Staff will be present until 10.30 pm so please ensure your daughter/son has made arrangements to be collected by this time.

The event includes a welcome drink (non-alcoholic), buffet menu, use of the Kings Suite, disco and professional security. A professional photographer will also be present.

The total cost for this package is £56.91 per student, to be paid by **Friday, 2nd May, 2025**. Payments must be made, and consent given, via MCAS (the Prom will show under the 'Trips' section on MCAS). If you do not already use MCAS, please go to www.mychildatschool.com and use the "forgotten password" link to set up your first password - your account is set up already. Please note that students will not be allowed to attend the Prom if payment has not been received or consent not provided on MCAS. Admission to the event is via the guest list. A confirmation ticket will be issued to students nearer the time.

In previous years, this event has been a very pleasurable way to celebrate the end of this important year. Parents, carers and students will also understand the need to express the following clear conditions which must be accepted by all those who attend:

- 1) It must be stressed that this Prom is totally alcohol and substance free. In the event of this condition not being met, then security staff will not admit a student to the event and they will need to be collected. Similarly, students may be removed from the event if this condition is not fully met **during** the event.
- 2) Whilst the event has always been celebrated in the right spirit previously, it should be noted that if there were to be any damage caused during this evening, any costs will be passed on to students and their families. All areas of the venue are covered by CCTV.
- 3) Unacceptable behaviour at school between now and the Prom may also result in students being told that they are unable to attend.

The Prom is a wonderful opportunity to celebrate their end of Year 11 at Sir Bernard Lovell Academy in a venue which is very fitting for such an excellent group of young people. We hope to see all students there.
