FOR STUDENTS IN YEARS 8-13	
First day back (see above)	Lessons will begin following Tutor period as normal. Report to Tutor rooms for 8.40am.
Break time and lunch	Break: 11.05-11.25am. Lunch: 1.25-2.05pm.
